## Rainbow stacker video games

This week, many players are engaged in Batman: Arkham Knight, the biggest game to launch in some time. But if the Dark Knight isn't your thing, or you're in the mood for something else to play, you're in luck: Lots of smaller games are heading in the way in the near future. Whether you're into fighting games, Japanese RPGs, or atmospheric adventure games, you'll probably find something that stands out of control this week.
1. BlazBlue Chrono Phantasma EXTEND is released June 30 for PS3, PS4 and Xbox One
If you are not a serious fan of fighting games, the BlazBlue series may have flown under the radar for the past six years. Although it may not have the name recognition of Street Fighter or Mortal Kombat, BlazBlue is still a solid series of games that have earned the respect of the hardcore fighting games community – which is no small task. The latest entry is a bloated-up re-release of BlazBlue Chrono Phantasma, a game that was launched on previous generation systems last year. New to the expansion are two more characters, a new phase, a brand new mode and a range of improved game mechanics that keep the characters balanced. If you are in the market for a serious, meaty fighting game, look no other way.
2. Hyperdimension Neptunia Re;Birth3: In Generation
Releases June 30 for PS Vita, a new hyperdimension on Vita seems to be released every other month. That's okay, 'cause it's all very fun. These action RPG are held in the pun-filled world of Gamindustri and star characters based on video game consoles. This installment begins when Neptune (a stand-in for Saturn's Sega) gets sued into an alternate dimension that is stuck in the late 1990s. It will take quite a bit to bring it back, especially since a group of seven powerful sages want to make sure it is gone for good. If you like JRPG and silly humor that breaks the fourth wall, check this out.
3. J-Stars Victory VS+ releases June 30 for PS4, PS3 and Vita
From jump manga sites and anime magazines in Japan comes this fighting game that pits characters from all kinds of anime series against each other. On the roster are fighters from Dragon Ball Z, Bleach, Naruto and many other series. It sounds like it might have limited attraction outside Japan, but apparently Namco Bandai thinks it's worth locating and releasing on this side of the Pacific. As for the game itself, it is a fairly standard 3-D fighting game. You are released into the big stages based on anime shows to compete in fast two-on-two battles. 4. Red Goddess: Inner World edition
June 30 for PS4
This indie game, successfully funded on Kickstarter, is a Metrodvania-style adventure, which means you'll explore a huge side-scrolling world and gain new powers as you progress. The game world actually exists inside the heroine's mind, with enemies being the embodiment of dark thoughts. looks interesting and may be a good idea to try if you are a fan of games like Super Metroid and Dust: An Elysian Tale.
5. Samurai Warriors Chronicles 3
News June 30 for Nintendo 3DS and PS Vita
Has the idea of using swords to slice your way through hordes of approaching enemies sound like a good time? Like the Dynasty Warrior series, this is exactly what you do in Samurai Warriors Chronicles 3. The premise of the game is that you participate in battles from an alternate version of Japanese history - battles that did not happen, but could happen if things turned out a little differently. There's a lot to play for, from strategizing with generals to hacking through thousands of enemies in different modes. If you're into Japanese history and hack-'n-slash combat, check it out.
6. Whispering Willows releases June 30 for PS4 and PS Vita
This atmospheric game puts you in the role of a girl who can send her spirit from the body where she can swim and interact with other spirits, good and bad. The goal is to explore the mysterious mansion, using your spirit to reach places that would otherwise be inaccessible, and solve puzzles to bring the story to its conclusion. Watch the trailer above to get an idea of what to expect from this cross-buy indie game.
7. Ar Nosurge Plus: Ode to the Unborn Stars
release July 2 for PS Vita
This Japanese RPG follows two separate pairs of characters as they make their way through a complex and interesting sci-fi universe. Although these two stories don't seem to have much in common at first, they start to come together in interesting ways as you head across the universe.
8. Ar Nosurge
launched on the PS3 last year with slightly positive reviews, but now makes its way to Sony's handheld system. If you're in the mood for a deep RPG to lose, this is probably your best bet. New technology developed specifically for video game systems is associated with other new technologies such as DVD. So how's the big three going to fight each other? Let's look at each system based on specific criteria. Let's start with the processors. PlayStation 3 uses a Cell processor. Developed by Toshiba and IBM specifically for the gaming system, the concept of this processor was to create a chip that acted like a biological cell in the body. It is distributed on a single chip. Cell processors can work together, allowing virtual supercomputers to be created by connecting multiple cell processors together. The Xbox 360 processor is a customized power-pc processor from IBM. It has three symmetric cores that run at 3.2 gigahertz (GHz). This processor has a lot of horsepower, but lacks the Cell architecture of the PlayStation 3 design. Nintendo Wii's not so impressive. It is an IBM Broadway 729 megahertz (MHz) processor. While the chip is not in the same league as its competitors, Nintendo executives say the processor is more than powerful enough to provide a fun gaming experience. Next, let's look at the graphics. The PlayStation 3 uses an RSX (GPU) graphics processor unit that runs at 550 MHz. Xbox 360 has an ATI 500 MHz GPU. The ATI Hollywood 243 MHz card powers graphics for the Nintendo Wii. PlayStation has an advantage on specs, although some gamers say they feel the Xbox makes better use of its capabilities than playstation. Meanwhile, Nintendo says the company wants to focus more on make games fun and less on enhancing graphics. Sound is a similar story. PlayStation 3 and Xbox 360 can deliver dolby surround sound. The Nintendo Wii can produce stereo sound and simulate surround sound, but again its specs lag behind the other two. All three systems can connect to the Internet. Microsoft's Xbox Live service is probably the strongest presence in console Internet games, but Sony is trying to change that. Nintendo made loyal fans very happy when it announced players will be able to purchase and download many classic games to the Wii system. All three companies are also exploring social networking applications through these video game systems. PlayStation 3 is also a Blu-ray DVD player that could give an advantage over the other two consoles. For people who want a Blu-ray player and a gaming system, the PlayStation 3 is an appealing choice. Before the end of the high-definition disc war, Microsoft released an external HD-DVD drive that users could connect to their Xbox 360 console, but ceased production in February 2008 after the HD-DVD format gave up the ghost [source: GamerScore Blog] For hardcore gamers, the choice usually boils down to either the PlayStation 3 or Xbox 360. While specs seem to favor Sony, other considerations, such as game libraries and online games, may attract gamers to Microsoft. Some players like to look at backward compatibility - can new systems play games designed for older systems? PS3 can play some games designed for the original PlayStation titles, but not for PS2. The Xbox 360 can play most Xbox games, but there may be compatibility issues with some games. The Nintendo Wii is a completely different beast. It appeals to casual players - people who are not necessarily interested in spending hours of time to hone their skills and become game masters. Hardcore gamers can enjoy Wii games too. While the 360 and PS3 feed players' bloodlust, the Wii seems to have a broader appeal. Which game console will rule supremely? Microsoft, Sony and Nintendo say their respective consoles will sell the most units. But no matter which company comes out on top, it's safe to say that all players are winners.
